

Wonderland Camp Job Descriptions

Cabin Leader: You must be at least 18 years old for this position. You will work with 10-12 campers in a cabin. You will oversee that campers and the staff in your cabin to make sure that campers are being helped with daily living skills, attending activities and to keep communication open between the staff and the Program Director.

Counselor: You must be at least 17 years old for this position. You will work with other staff members including a Cabin Leader working with campers on daily living skills, daily activities and being a part of cabin life.

Counselor in Training: You must be 16 years old for this position. You will work with Cabin Leaders and Counselors working with campers on daily activities, daily living skills and being a part of camp life. This position requires two weeks of volunteer training before it is a paid position.

Medical Staff: You must have a RN, LPN or CMT certification. You will work and live in the infirmary during the week, addressing the medical needs of the campers and staff.

Program Staff: You must be at least 18 years old for this position. You will specialize and plan creative activities for one of the following areas: Crafts, Music, Nature, Game Room or Recreation. You will also participate in all camp activities.

Lifeguard: You must have a lifeguard certification from a valid organization, such as the Red Cross or equivalent to. You will supervise waterfront and pool activities and participate in all camp activities.
