



COVID-19 Update

Wonderland Camp cares deeply about the health of all our campers. We hope you are doing well and staying safe.

- At this time, we still expect the first week of camp to start on May 23rd. However, if we must cancel the camp session you are registered for because of COVID-19 CDC guidelines, you will receive a full, 100% refund.
- Also, if you cannot come to camp because you have been exposed to COVID-19 and are following the CDC guidelines for isolation or you test positive within 14 days of your registered camp session, you will receive a full, 100% refund. You will need to provide exposure or positive test results to the camp in order to obtain the refund. Otherwise, if you choose to cancel your registration for any other reason, then our regular Refund Policy will apply.

Our Refund Policy

- We refund a deposit up until ten weeks before the Sunday the camper is due to arrive. You must call camp to arrange the refund.
- We refund half the deposit up until six weeks before the Sunday the camper is due to arrive. You must call camp to arrange the refund.
- We refund half the deposit if the camper is hospitalized during the three days before he/she is due to arrive at camp or if a parent or guardian dies during that time.
- We do not issue any refunds within six weeks of the first day of camp or if a camper leaves camp for any reason after checking in on Sunday.
